Change of Auditor

Tertiary Minerals plc (AIM: TYM), the explorer focused on energy transition and precious metals in Zambia and Nevada, announces the appointment of MAH, Chartered Accountants (“MAH”) as the Group’s auditor with effect from 19 June 2026.

MAH will conduct the audit of the Company’s financial statements for the financial year ending 30 September 2026 and their appointment as the Company’s auditor will be subject to the approval of shareholders at the Company’s next Annual General Meeting, to be held in 2027.
